## Pronunciation:

"ou" = Usually /av/ (south),
but sometimes / $\wedge$ / (young), /D/(cough ), /əঠ/ (shoulder), /ঠ/ (would).
"u" = Usually / $\Lambda /$ (rush),
but also often /v/ (push), /(j)u:/ (puke).
'ur' usually /з:/ (turn).
$" \mathrm{o} "=\quad$ Usually $/ \mathrm{D} /$ (bother), / $\Lambda /$ (love), or /əঠ/ (hope).
